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#### Dear Parish Council

As you may be aware Holly and myself run Bubblewrap After School Club in Longwick, until Easter this year we ran out of the Scout Hut which unfortunately has been repurposed thus leaving us homeless.

The school has very kindly offered us space within the school building, however the current available space does not meet the needs of the children in our care. Below is an outline of the care we strive to provide.

Our aim is to provide sessions where there is time for children to choose, to relax and explore through play – either independently or with other children – or join in with one of the fun activities led by our friendly, experienced and qualified staff.

Children are free to choose activities and resources as they wish. There will always be a selection of activities and resources available, including dressing up, craft, board games, construction, computer games, physical play, cookery, and reading.

No matter how children choose to spend their time, whether it's indoors or outside, we encourage them to be self-confident and self-reliant, to help further their development as individuals.

Our clubs are Ofsted-registered, and offer either half or full sessions, to suit family's needs.

We would like to improve the environment we have for the after school club and meet the needs of all children joining us. We also recognise the increased need for wrap-around care due to the growth of Longwick.

Jade (Headteacher) has kindly offered us the use of the Stem Lab but this needs thorough repurposing to enable us to provide the care we wish to.

In carrying out the project, we feel we can not only support more families with wrap-around care but also children in the community with SEND and complex needs within Longwick School. Our shared vision with the school is to create a nurturing space with soft furnishing and accessible storage, incorporating a much needed sensory provision.

In the school day this area would be a vital addition, providing a safe space for children with SEND, the SENDco and the family liaison officer to carry out their essential work.

In addition to the Stem Lab the kitchen and eating area within the school is limited. To enable us to provide food we would ideally like to be able to add more storage units to the walls, a new cooker and large capacity fridge (instead of the milk fridge

we currently use). This would benefit all the children that attend Longwick School not just those that attend Bubblewrap. Currently the children eat in the School Hall on the lunch tables. From September this will not be possible as the external sports provision will have the use of the Hall. As a knock on effect this will leave us needing tables and chairs to eat at (appox 20).

Unfortunately we do not have the finances to undertake this massive task and therefore wish to apply for a grant from the Parish Council to enable us to realise our shared dreams. Please see below an outline of the work required and estimated cost.

- · Clear down of the room
- · Repaint
- Re-floor
- Storage units
- · Sensory items such as bubble lamps and sensory walls
- Celebration wall for bubble wrap children and their nurturing activities with us
- Soft furnishings

### Work to be carried out and resources needed

- · Units on the kitchen walls added for storage
- X18 chairs and tables
- New cooker and new fridge (large capacity to help with storing our foods)
- Repaint of the area to make is more attractive and welcoming for the children
