TO CONSIDER SUMMER ACTIVITIES IN THE PARISH

Idea from Cllr Ayre

Creation Station

If they are going to be dropped off it would be nice to give parents a decent chunk of time for meeting or errands etc. Two afternoons from 1pm-4pm? I have availability on Wednesday 5th and Thursday 6th August.

To allow me to take responsibility for children I will need to also bring an additional member of staff and work to a ratio, so with two of us we can accept up to 20 children aged 5 upwards.

3 hours will give me enough time to do several craft activities, and we will provide some exciting themes. I would make sure we include one craft that is a bit more premium so they have something nice to take home as well as some more paper based stuff. I would bring table cloths, painting aprons etc with me. I think it would also be simplest if I provide some fruit and an ice pop snack too (Is there a freezer in the kitchen?). It would probably be nice to take them outside for a while during this time, so I will need to pop in before hand to do a proper risk assessment.

Our cost would be £300 per day, which works out at around £15 per child if you have 20. Our half day holiday camps usually cost £20 per child, so I hope this represents great value.

Theme choices could be:

Arabian Nights
Down Under
Cowboys
Science
Under the Sea
Mythical Creatures
Wizard School

We use our themes to help inspire children, add some discussion and break the ice and to make sure we have wide appeal to both girls and boys and across the age ranges. We support younger children a wee bit more during activities and try to challenge older children to expand their work, so we can make the same activity accessible for all ages.

Idea from Cllr Livingston:

Family BBQ

A family BBQ and music on the field. (Maybe a Cllr Gummer can do some games for the younger ones) Cllr Livingston has offered to do the music if cost is tight otherwise get someone in. Suggestions: Longwick Lions to hold a mini football tournament. Local option for the BBQ. Possibly one Saturday in mid-August 2-5pm. Parish Council could perhaps pay for one burger for example ensuring for residents residing in Parish.

Idea from Cllr Smith

My research focussed on a split of activities - Indoors and outdoors with age group splits too (6-9yrs & 10-12yrs).

Session 1 - Young indoors and older Outdoors 10am to 12 noon - Parachute Party £249 and Sports Party £259

With Village Hall costs likely budget needed circa £1400. Date currently proposed 5th August.

Ideas from Cllr Gummer:

JR sports activity afternoon 3hrs x2 days

For two hours of Sumo and Zorbs, we charge £500 + VAT. This price includes 2 staff members who are fully first aid trained and DBS checked

Some other services we can provide (2 hours for £350 + VAT).

- Beat the GK
- Soft Archery
- Big game of rounders (this will be better than cricket, as it is more inclusive and more people can get a go, minimum of 16 people required)
- Football Match (minimum of 10)

Frisbee golf

Location - Longwick Park

Time - 9am to 4pm

Course consists of 9 holes - each hole is pop up fly disc net or a flag with a large hula hoop at its base.

Players throw their frisbee and aim to land it in the net or hoop, if they miss they then throw from where it lands, just like golf and record how many strokes (throws) it takes to hole their frisbee.

Risk level low

Players aren't catching frisbees so are unlikely to cut hands on discs

They could land in or near dog poo that hasn't been cleaned up. A scan of the course will be done prior and any poo removed.

Wild frisbee throws could strike other players or members of the public. The course will be contained to the skate park and MUGA end of the field potentially with taping.

Players play at their own risk


